## Please always wear

- Those who given the "Entrance Permit" (in principle, up to two persons)
  - 1 Visiting inpatients (those given prior permission)
  - 2 Those whom exchange items such as laundry and daily necessities, etc.

Please hand items to the staff near the ward counter.

You cannot enter a ward room.

Visiting hours are as follow:

2 p.m. - 7 p.m. everyday

4th floor of East Wing: 2 p.m.-6 p.m.

- 3 Those whom the hospital has asked to visit for explanation of the patient's medical condition
- 4 Those whom the hospital has permit when admission, discharge and operation
- **5** Those whom the hospital has permit to attend the patients

<Physical condition check request>

People who fall into any of the following symptoms are prohibited from entering the hospital ward.

- 1. has a body temperature of 37.5 or higher
- 2. has cough such as cough, phlegm, etc., in the past week
- 3. has strong feeling of fatigue and/or difficulty in breathing
- 4. has been in contact a patient with epidemic diseases, such as influenza, gastroenteritis, varicella, measles, rubella, mumps, COVID-19
